Primary REALTOR® or REALTOR® Associate Membership Application Instructions

A basic prerequisite for membership is that you be licensed with a firm whose broker is a REALTOR® member and/or MLS Participant of HCAR and/or HCIS. Before proceeding with the membership application, please verify that your license is showing as "current, active" with the proper firm by visiting the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation's (DBPR) website at www.myfloridalicense.com. The DBPR requires that licenses of agents, brokers and corporations be current and showing as active on their website prior to HCAR or HCIS processing membership applications.

1. Complete the Application.

- A. Complete EVERY blank in the application. (If not applicable, fill in N/A.)
- B. Read the attached **Membership Agreements**, date and sign. **Return with the application.**
- C. Provide a copy of your current real estate license or state certification to engage in the appraisal of real property is required. *Return with the application.*
- D. Provide a completed, dated and signed RE 10, which also needs to be dated and signed by your Broker. *RE-10 form must be received prior to calling.*
- E. A letter of "Good Standing" is required if you are currently or ever have been a member of another Association or Board.
- 2. Call the membership department to schedule an appointment time convenient for all.
- 3. Pay Appropriate Fees.

A. Include with the application, check, cash or credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover, American Express -. The <u>date of affiliation</u> with a "Designated" REALTOR governs the amount you pay.

- 4. Dues are pro-rated for new members and can be calculated using the pro-ration charts provided for REALTORS® or REALTOR® Associates.
- 5. Attend Orientation Class Professional Standards Class

A. An applicant shall take and satisfactorily complete the required Professional Standards Class COE) within 60 days. If the courses are not completed, the application fee may be forfeited and the applicant may be required to reapply for membership. Also the mandated MLS class is taken at this time.

5. Board of Directors Review.

A. Upon completion of the above steps, the application is submitted to the Board of Directors for final review and approval. **Once the application has been approved by the Board of Directors, there will be no refunds.**

Secondary REALTOR® or REALTOR® Associate Membership

Steps 1-4 are the same as for Primary Members except that Secondary Members will <u>only</u> Pay local (HCAR) dues, since their State and National dues are paid thru their Primary Association. A letter of "Good Standing" is required from the Primary Association with The date of completion of the COE, and that the State and National dues have been paid.

What is a REALTOR-ASSOCIATE®?

REALTOR-ASSOCIATE® Members shall be those independent contractors and salesmen who are affiliated with or employed by a REALTOR® Member or a firm, partnership, or corporation of which any REALTOR® Member is a sole proprietor, partner or officer, who are actively engaged in the real estate business and who are deemed qualified for REALTOR-ASSOCIATE® membership by a local board within the state in which the independent contractor or salesman is actively engaged in the real estate business or within a state whose border is contiguous with that state, or if the real estate firm is located outside the jurisdiction of any local board, by the state association within whose territory the independent contractor or salesman is actively engaged in the real estate business having an effective membership agreement with the National Association as provided in Article XV, Section 2.

The NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® is the proud owner of numerous MARKS, including but not limited to the REALTOR® LOGO, and the terms REALTOR®, REALTOR-ASSOCIATE®, REALTORS®, and REALTOR-ASSOCIATE®s, which may be referred to collectively as the MARKS.

This manual explains the application of guidelines to assist in the proper use of the MARKS.

The MARKS are collective membership marks which serve to identify members of the National Association and distinguish them from non-members. Since 1916, when the unique term REALTOR® was first established, the public has come to recognize those who use the MARKS as members of the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®.

Preservation of trademarks requires that they be used only in their trademarked form. They should be distinguished from traditional words and must always include the registration symbol "®."

The purpose of this manual is to protect the MARKS and assure that they are used consistently.

REALTOR® is a registered collective membership mark which may be used only by real estate professionals who are members of the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® and subscribe to its strict Code of Ethics.

Please Note: As a Realtor Associate member on the local level (HCAR) your initial fees Application and Local dues are less, and you would not vote on any issues that require a vote of members. You can at any time upgrade to a REALTOR member by paying the \$150 difference in the original application fee, and then there is a \$40 difference in the local dues annually.

What Is A REALTOR®?

Simply put, a REALTOR® is someone who is licensed by the state to practice real estate, and who has chosen to become a member of the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR), the largest trade organization in the world.

Real estate brokers and agents who wish to be REALTORS® must first become a member of a local board, such as the Hernando County Association of REALTORS®. This automatically makes them members of the Florida REALTORS®, www.floridarealtors.org and the National Association of REALTORS® www.realtor.org

Before being admitted into membership though, the salesperson or broker pledges to abide by the association's rules and regulations as well as those of the National Association of REALTORS®. Membership is open to all qualified individuals regardless of race, color, religion, sex, ancestry, handicap, familial status or national origin.

Yet the term REALTOR® does not tell the whole story. For example, it does not refer to just one profession. REALTORS® may be engaged in virtually any part of the real estate business including real estate management, mortgage brokers, appraisers, developers and builders, in addition to those involved in real estate brokerage.

Another part of the story is professionalism: REALTORS® are bound by a strict Code of Ethics which other real estate agents have not pledged to uphold. This Code, an expression of the highest ideals of the organized real estate industry, is strictly enforced by the Hernando County Association of REALTORS®.

All REALTORS®, by virtue of their membership in the association, have pledged to uphold the principles and standards of practice in the Code. It both governs their behavior and protects them, and the public, from the abuses of the marketplace. As one REALTOR® put it, "It is the heart and soul of our organization."

Remember that the term REALTOR® is a collective membership mark which only refers to members of the National Association of REALTORS®. Just as every photocopy is not a Xerox®, not every real estate agent is a REALTOR®. Only REALTORS® can display this registered trademark:
